David Shaw, NLHD CEO/Administrator

Mr. Shaw accepted the position of Chief Executive Officer in 1999 at Nor-Lea Hospital District in Lovington, New Mexico where he currently serves today in a community of 14,000 residents. During his tenure, Nor-Lea Hospital District has seen a rapid growth in the scope of services and the size of the facility. In 1999 Nor-Lea Hospital District employed 5 providers and 89 staff members. Today Nor-Lea Hospital District employs 65 providers and over 550 staff members. The hospital is one of the largest Critical Access Hospitals in the country with approximately \$125 million in net patient revenue and performing over 180,000 outpatient visits and nearly 110,000 clinic visits. Nor-Lea Hospital District's scope of services today include ER, inpatient care, general surgery, gynecology, ENT, pain management, neurology, wound care, cardiology, gastroenterology, rheumatology, 4 Rural Health Clinics, 2 school-based clinics, a mobile clinic, wellness center and a cancer center.

Nor-Lea Hospital District under his tenure has also received national awards in customer and employee engagement. In 2017 David Shaw was recognized statewide for his leadership skills with the "Don Chambers Passion for Excellence Award". Nor-Lea Hospital District was named in 2018 as the recipient of the Quality New Mexico's "Zia Award for Performance Excellence" New Mexico's highest award for business excellence.

David Shaw has been married to Frances Shaw for 34 years and has two children; David, Abby and seven grandchildren. In his spare time, he enjoys spending time with his family participating in outdoor activities such as mountain climbing, hiking, and hunting. David also serves his community in several capacities including New Mexico Health Insurance Exchange Board as Chairman, New Mexico Hospital Association Board member, Lea County EDC Vice Chair, Yellowstone RRG a national insurance Board as Vice Chair, Rotary and his church.
